We will soon be entering the season of Lent. That is right it is almost time to start looking towards Easter once again. We will begin this Lenten journey by celebrating Ash Wednesday with our friends at Lawrence Chapel UMC. During the season of Lent we will be studying the book *24 Hours That Changed The World* by Adam Hamilton. The book looks at the last 24 hours of Jesus life from the Gospel of Mark. There will be an opportunity for you to purchase a 40 day devotional that goes along with the series, and we will make that available for pre-order soon.

I wanted to take a moment to share with you a little about Lent. Some of you may have grown up with Lent your whole life and know all about it. Some of you may have grown up with it your whole life and know nothing about it. And yet, some of you may have never heard of it or really know what I am talking about. Lent is really a season of preparation and self-examination. We begin Lent with Ash Wednesday which is a time for us to think about our own sin and our own mortality. It is a chance to confess where we have gone wrong in our lives. Confession is always the first step toward repentance and forgiveness. We must first recognize our own faults.


Lent then moves for 40 days not counting Sundays as a time for us to look at our lives. In the early church Lent was a 40 days not counting Sundays preparation for baptism. People would study Scripture, pray, fast, and prepare themselves for being born anew in Christ. For some Lent is a season to make a sacrifice. If that is your tradition I encourage you to do that in a way that honors a focus towards Christ. I always encourage people to take up something for Lent such as a prayer time, devotional time, Scripture reading time, or some other spiritual discipline to draw us closer to God.


UMW Valentine's Dish meal—Sunday, February 12

Bonfire and Hayride:





The Council discussed and agreed that there is a need for the handicapped bathroom but decided some other factors need to be considered before we take on this project. Most importantly, relocation of the church office and the internet and phone lines that would be displaced by



the construction. The Council voted to form a committee that would create a long range plan for the use of our facility, including the placement of a handicapped bathroom while taking into account our current and future needs for office, classroom, storage, and bathroom space. The Council directed Pastor Gene to create a Long Range Planning Team that will consist of 5 members and Pastor Gene. Their goal will be to come up with a comprehensive facility use plan taking into consideration needs and limitations of the space we have. We encourage you to pray for this team.
